Summary of the main achievements of the charity during the financial period

The last year has been characterised by an increase in community spirit, most obviously around the Juniper Green 300 celebrations in which the Association participated. Assistance with several projects demonstrated that community events can still be successful. The continued benefit from these activities is shown in the progress being made with the development of the Juniper Green 300 Monument project. Also undertaken in the past year has been the leaflet/poster of Juniper Green the Village and its River. Distribution of this to new residents of the Village in future years usefully serves to introduce them to our community. Helping to guard against the continued threat of over-development is a role that continues to be necessary. Assistance was given by many people to the public enquiry for the Splash Bathrooms site.

Financial review

The charity holds funds which have been provided to the charity over time through donations, events and bank interest. Under the terms of the Constitution, the charity must use the assets to support its charitable activities for the improvement of the amenity of the Village and the fulfilment of the Aims and Objectives

The unrestricted funds represent income earned but not yet utilised in supporting charitable activities. At 1 April 2008 the charity held £8.007 at the bank and the Trustees consider this to be appropriate to allow them to undertake the charitable aims.
